After the discussion it was agreed upon by the members present for Mr. Firestine to check into Henrico's schedule and report back on the December 6 meeting.

Outreach and Engagement Update: In October, the Team had several new outreach opportunities that proved extremely fruitful. They attended a resource fair hosted by the Office of Aging and Disability Services. This fair was geared toward citizens with disabilities and provided information on community resources and employment opportunities. Also, they attended two Resource/Vendor fairs hosted by the Department of Social Services. This was an internal event for social services staff.

In the community, the Team attended the Entrepreneur Expo and sent materials to a Human Services table at Pride. The Team also manned two library card sign-up tables at Cabell Library at VCU totally approximately 60 new library cards. Finally, the Team represented RPL at the Thomas B. Smith Community Center Active Aging Resource Fair and Open House.

For youth events, the Team was invited to and attended Harvest Fest at Martin Luther King Jr. Middle School as well as Oak Grove-Bellemeade Elementary's Fall Festival. At the end of the October, the Team participated in a Trunk or Treat at the Virginia Museum of History and Culture. This event was attended by over 1,000 people.

Digitally, the Outreach & Engagement Department in conjunction with the Foundation, sent out email updates to all the City Council liaisons as well as the October "RPL at Home" Newsletter. The Team also conducted special advertising efforts for the RPL 100 Celebration, Special Collections Open House, and the Read Up Richmond programs.

Things to Celebrate: Stories from our locations of things to celebrate that happened during the month.

- Belmont Branch Library: Turnout for our RPL100 Celebration was small, but it was wonderful that one gentleman, Jerome Jones, recognized himself in the presentation that LCSM Ben Himmelfarb was making. Mr. Jones was laughing and soon his son and all of us were laughing. This RPL patron was featured registering to vote many years ago at Belmont, as well as walking out the front door. We helped re-enact the same image for photographs of Mr. Jones in the current setting. Mr. Jones is going to write up a few words, when done, Mr. Himmelfarb will be working with him to use these words to be the capstone entry in the RPL Stories and Memories project.
- **East End Branch Library:** Several individuals who have been unemployed for some time have been able to get jobs because of the efforts of staff here and our partnerships with the OCWB. Three separate people came back and thanked us for our help in recommending open positions and working with them on their resumes, so that they could get jobs.
- **Ginter Park Branch Library:** Two kids came to the library during our Popsicle Stick Catapult event, not knowing that it was going on. They immediately became completely engrossed in the activity and were excitedly telling their mom about it at the end. They left with two functioning popsicle stick catapults!
- Hull Street Branch Library: YWCA Sprout School is visiting for pre-school storytimes!

Things to Celebrate (Continued):

• Main Library: Librarian, Senior Meg Raymond was working with a young woman who wanted to read a series that RPL only has in Hoopla audiobooks. Ms. Raymond asked if listening to books was something she'd consider, and the lady replied "oh, my mind wanders when I listen to books unless I am doing something with my hands, I really need to learn to knit". Ms. Raymond suggested, how about learning to crochet? RPL has classes for that? WHAT? YES PLEASE. Ms. Raymond help the lady the Hoopla application downloaded and showed her how to register for classes and she danced away.

Ms. Raymond also helped two young women who asked for recommendations for fantasy titles, especially retellings of myths or fairy tales. She showed them RPL Readers page, and one lady shoved the other and said, "OMG LIKE PLAYLISTS FOR BOOKS." They both also checked out 3-4 books each from Gothic/Dark Academia displays.

- North Avenue Branch Library: During the month of October, four patrons were able to use library services that helped receive gainful employment and two patrons were able to obtain housing thanks to library services and resources.
- Westover Hills Branch Library: A patron who has been visiting the library for the past few months to work on an intense degree program finished up that program and came to the desk to thank the staff for making such a warm, inviting, and quiet space to study. He remarked that he'd said it before and he'd say it again, we were a key factor to success for him in that course. He made sure to tell us he'd be coming back for the quiet space regularly, even without the program lighting a fire under his feet.
