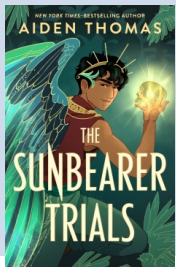

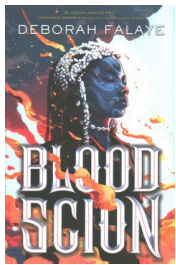
The Sunbearer Trials

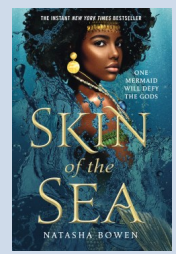
So Let Them Burn

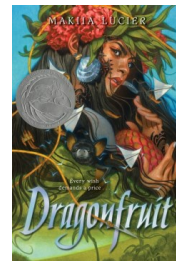
Skin of the Sea

Dragonfruit

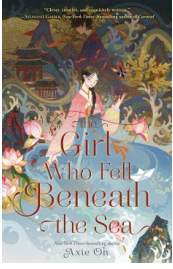
by Makiia Lucier

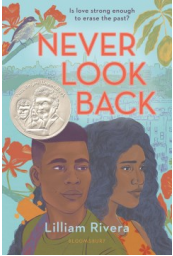


The Girl Who Fell Beneath the Sea

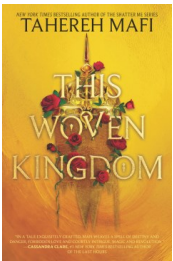
mythology retelling.

by Rivera, Lilliam

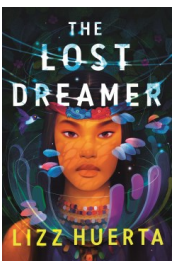

by Salisbury, Melinda

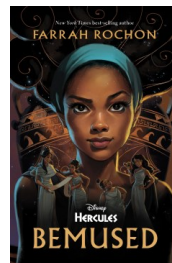
