by Uru-Chan

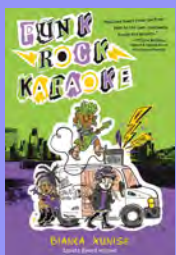

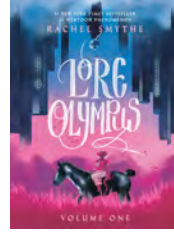
